Meeting was called to order by:

Commissioner Norris

Minutes:

Minutes from the February 18, 2026 meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Grant Office — Public Hearing #1:

Nicole Birney read the notice of public hearing #1 for FY 2026 Ohio Department of Development Office of Community Development. The hearing was to provide information on upcoming state or federally funded grant opportunities offered through the ODOT and the State of Ohio. Programs that may be available include, but are not limited to, Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program, Housing Assistance, Downtown & Neighborhood Revitalization, Critical & Residential Public Infrastructure, Economic Development, Abandon Gas Station Cleanup, Roadwork Development, Demolition & Brownfield Site Revitalization.

No public comments were made.

Sheriff Mark Touville:

Touville introduced an agreement accepting a \$18,765.19 grant used for special response team equipment.

Agreement 11-26:

JAG Pre-Award Grant condition forms for government/public and private agencies. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Purchase Orders & Vouchers:

Job & Family Services requested approval of their vouchers from Public Assistance totaling \$2,386.96 and \$3,078.76, and Children Services totaling \$72.00. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve, seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Sheriff's Office requested approval of their purchase orders and vouchers totaling \$1,346.69. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Engineer's Office requested approval of their purchase orders and vouchers totaling \$38,220.97. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Commissioners' Office requested approval of their purchase orders and vouchers totaling \$9,160,437.50. Of this amount, \$9,110,437.50 will be applied to pay off the loan with Huntington Bank for the new jail, and \$50,000.00 represents the bond counsel fee. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Appropriations:

Commissioners' Office requested an increase in appropriations by \$9,110,437.50 in E0010-N006-N01.120 (Justice Center Expenses). The increase is needed to pay off the loan with Huntington Bank. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Soil & Water:

Soil & Water Conservation District requested an increase in appropriations by \$27,399.00 in A207-A01.180 (Soil & Water). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Soil & Water Cont.:

Soil & Water requested a transfer in the amount of \$231,811.00 from E0230-A207-A01 to R0130-L001-L02 (County Grants Line). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Resolutions:**Resolution 12-26:**

A disposal resolution from the Harrison County Recorder's Office. The Harrison County Board of Commissioners has resolved that the HP Printer Laser Jet 600, Adler Royal Typewriter, five monitors, eight towers, and miscellaneous items in the custody of the Recorder's Office are unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for the purpose for which they were acquired, and the value of said property is less than \$2,500. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Agreements:**Addendum to Agreement 47-25:**

Addendum to the Agreement between Harrison County Board of Commissioners and the Village of Hopedale to provide financial assistance in support of the Village's infrastructure project. The parties wish to amend the total financial contribution from the board shall not exceed \$123,642.86 instead of the original amount of \$85,003.00. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve the addendum; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes. Corder noted that the percent of local share funds will increase the Village's chances to secure the loan.

Claims Docket Report:

Claims docket report batch #5735 was received, totaling \$89,674.98. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Executive Session:

Commissioner Corder made a motion to enter executive session at 10:12 a.m. to discuss confidential business information about an application for economic development assistance R.C. 121.22(G)(8); seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

At 10:29 a.m., Commissioner Corder motioned to re-enter session with no action taken; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

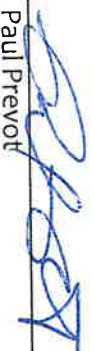
Public Comment:
