### Meeting was called to order by:

### Minutes:

Minutes from the December 22, 2025 meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Minutes from the January 5, 2026 Reorganization meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

### Tri-County Help Center—Danielle Manbeck and Jaque Galloway:

Manbeck spoke about upcoming events for Human Trafficking Awareness Month including the proclamation, Wear Blue Day, a training series “Building a Safety Net,” the Blue Campaign, Blue Heart Awareness Event at 11 a.m. Jan. 30 at the Puskarich Public Library, and Breaking the Silence — a mannequin display shining a light on the hidden realities of human trafficking.

Galloway added that the events were created using the input from the 18 survivors from 2025 and what would best help them and others. She said they also partnered with the task force to create initiatives that would help support survivors such as partnering with local food pantries.

### **Resolution 1-26:**

Proclamation recognizing January as Human Trafficking Prevention Month in Harrison County, and urge all residents, businesses and organizations to join in raising awareness, supporting survivors, and working toward a future free from human trafficking. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve the resolution; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

### Appropriations:

Commissioners’ Office requested an increase in appropriations by \$5,000.00 in A15-A13 (Memberships—Commissioners). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Common Pleas Court General Division requested an increase in appropriations by \$2,252.55 in B092-B01 (Salary) and \$52.00 in B092-B02 (Medicare). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Common Pleas Court Juvenile/Probate Division requested appropriation increases by \$36,316.80 in E0280-D006-D01.010 (Salary), \$5,200.00 in E0280-D006-D02.050 (PERS), \$7,500.00 in E0280-D006-D03.090 (Health/Life/Eye), \$550.00 in E0280-D006-D04.070 (Medicare), \$750.00 in E0280-D006-D05.040 (Worker's Comp), \$2,500.00 in E0280-D006-D07.030 (Drug Tests), \$2,500.00 in E0280-D006-D08.080 (MAT Medications), \$2,500.00 in E0280-D006-D09.060 (Recovery Supports), and \$2,500.00 in E0280-D006-D10.140 (Treatment Services). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Common Pleas Court Juvenile/Probate Division requested an increase in appropriations by \$7,500.00 in D13-D01 (Intervention). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Common Pleas Court Juvenile/Probate Division requested appropriation increases by \$30,000.00 in Do8-D01 (IV-E/ Maintenance) and \$30,000.00 in Do8-D02 (IV-E/Admin). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Common Pleas Court Juvenile/Probate Division requested appropriation increases by \$25,237.60 in E0280-A002-E01.001 (Salary), \$89,540.34 in E0280-A002-E02.010 (Salary—Employees), \$16,882.06 in E0280-A002-E03.050 (PERS), \$37,537.58 in E0280-A002-E04.090 (Hospitalization), \$3,885.95 in E0280-A002-E05.040 (Workers Comp), \$1,938.34 in E0280-A002-E06.070 (Medicare/Life/Eye), \$1,874.56 in E0280-A002-E08.030 (Supplies), \$630.46 in E0280-A002-E10.100 (Contracts/Repairs), and \$878.50 in E0280-A002-E11.170 (Education/Travel). **Resolutions:**

**Resolution 2-26:**

A resolution to designate the official representative and alternate for the purpose of voting at the annual meeting of the County Commissioners' Association of Ohio in 2026. Commissioner Norris is designated as the official voting representative and Commissioner Prevot is designated as the alternate voting representative of Harrison County. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

**Other:**

Commissioner Corder read a letter of support addressed to Ohio Rail Development Commission Director Matthew Dietrich to show support and encourage the ORDC to extend the Panhandle Line lease and operating agreement with Columbus & Ohio River Rail Road who is seeking a long-term extension on the state-owned lease. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve and send the letter; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.
