Meeting was called to order by: Commissioner Norris

Minutes:

Minutes from the July 15, 2026 meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. Commissioner Norris abstained from the motion. The motion was carried with Corder and Prevot both voting yes.

Executive Session:

Commissioner Corder motioned to enter into executive session at 10:01 a.m. to discuss personnel matters, R.C. 121.22 (G)(1), and invited Rebecca Miller and Prosecutor Lauren Knight to join them. Commissioner Prevot seconded the motion. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.
—Commissioners went into the conference room for the closed door session.

Commissioner Corder motioned to come out of executive session at 10:31 a.m. with no action taken; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Purchase Orders & Vouchers:

Job & Family Services requested approval of their vouchers from the Public Assistance fund totaling \$5,144.81 and \$157.36; and Children Services fund totaling \$14,883.31. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Appropriations:

Commissioners' Office requested an increase in appropriations by \$12,500.00 in B000-B03.030 (Utilities — Dog Pound). Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Agreements:

Agreement 27-26:

Harrison County Highway Department Road Use Maintenance Agreement between Harrison County and Ascent Resources — Utica, LLC. The operator intends to commence use of a portion of CR 86, beginning at US 250 and ending at the intersection of Georgetown Road (CR 41) for a distance of 1.36 miles; and a portion of CR 41, beginning at CR 86 and ending the coordinates 40.197514, -80.950719, for a distance of 0.91 miles. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Resolutions:

Resolution 51-26:

Disposal resolution. The Harrison County Treasurer has informed the Harrison County Board of Commissioners that they have two printers that are unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for the purpose for which it was acquired, and the value of said property is less than \$2,500, and wishes to dispose of said property. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve the resolution; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Claims Docket Report:

Claims docket report batch #5854 was received, totaling \$271,223.14. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Contracts:**Addendum to Contract 13-26:**

Purchase of the Performance of Services Contract Clarification. The document is to clarify that the contract is for the purchase of work experience services only. Commissioner Corder motioned to approve the addendum; seconded by Commissioner Prevot. The motion was carried with Corder, Prevot and Norris all voting yes.

Public Comment:

Paul Cameron asked how long RUMAs are good for.
Commissioner Corder said the RUMA remains in effect until they request a release from the Engineer's Office.
Prosecutor Knight confirmed what Corder said and added that the language indicating how long the company plans to utilize the roads is usually included in the agreement.
Cameron asked if they have heard anything further about the data centers since the previous time he attended a meeting.
Corder said they had not.
